

## PARKS DESIGNATED AS GRASSROOTS ART SITE: RULES AND REGULATIONS

Monroe County Code: 1986, § 19.05

(1) **Food and Beverages**

- (a) No food or beverages of any nature, alcohol or non-alcohol, are allowed in the park site.
- (b) No picnics, cookouts, or fires are allowed in the park site.

(2) **Camping**

- (a) Camping, during daylight hours or overnight, is not allowed in the park site.

(3) **Groups**

- (a) No private parties or group celebration of any nature may be held at the park site.
- (b) No juvenile groups are allowed in the park site unless accompanied by one adult for every ten juveniles.
- (c) Small groups or bus tours may tour and view the park with or without a guide provided by the Monroe County Local History Room & Museum (MCLHR).

(4) **Weddings**

Weddings may be held at the park by registering with the MCLHR (608-269-8680) and completing arrangements. Procedure shall include:

- (a) Registration on the Wegner Grotto calendar with the MCLHR Director.
- (b) Sign a waiver as per County requirement, to be filed by the MCLHR Director in the Wegner Grotto wedding file at the Monroe County Local History Room & Museum.
- (c) Complete the wedding registration form, with the original filed in the Wegner Grotto file at the MCLHR, and copies made by the MCLHR Director to be given to the Wegner Grotto Committee and the couple registering.
- (d) Give a \$50.00 donation to the Wegner Grotto fund (to be paid in advance) for weddings performed in the church proper. A member of the Wegner Grotto Committee must be in attendance at the wedding ceremony.
- (e) The maximum number of wedding party members within the church proper shall not exceed seven.
- (f) Wedding ceremonies only may be performed at the site. No reception, food or beverages of any nature shall be allowed in conjunction with a wedding.

(5) **Refuse**

No person shall discard or leave any refuse, sewage, or other waste material on the grounds of the park site.

(6) **Pets**

No pets of any type are allowed in the park site.

(7) **No person shall climb upon, lean against, or have physical contact with any of the art structures in the park site.**

(8) **Hours of Operation**

The park site will be open officially to the public Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend: 8:00AM – 8:00PM. The rest of the year: 8:00AM – 5:00PM. However, November 1 through May 1 some of the folk art structures in the park site will be winterized in plastic domes.

(9) **All rules and regulations of Statute 19.03 of the ordinance apply with full force and effect to parks designated as grassroots art sites, except where this section is more restrictive.**
